- Alternative Text (Alt Text): All images and media elements have descriptive alt text.
- Accessible Forms: Clear labels, error messages, and logical tab navigation.
- Video Captions and Transcripts: Multimedia content includes captions or transcripts.
- Ongoing efforts & feedback

## Ongoing Accessibility Improvements

We are continuing to make improvements in the following areas of our website:

- PDFs and other documents - some of our older PDFs and Word documents may not meet accessibility standards - for example, they may not be structured so that they are accessible to a screen reader. We will continue to work through older documents to amend. All new documents from June 2025 will be screen reader compatible.
- Colour Contrast: Text and background colours are being reviewed to meet contrast ratio guidelines.
